This Indenture Made and entered into the 4th day of August year 1849
and between Benjamin Worrell and Nancy Worrell his wife of the one part and
William & Wilson of the other part: This Indenture Witnesseth that the
Benjamin Worrell and Nancy his wife have for and in consideration of the sum
of seven hundred dollars and fifty cents to them in hand paid by the said
William & Wilson at the making and delivery of these presents. The Receipt of which
is hereby acknowledged have in consideration thereof bargained and sold with
them the said William & Wilson and do and each of them doth bargain
sell unto him the said William & Wilson all the right like interest and
estate which they the said Benjamin Worrell and Nancy his wife now
have or may hereafter have in and to the Lands whereon the said William
& Wilson now live or any part of the same which Lands is bounded by the
Lands of the following named persons to wit: Adlai Pope, James Warden
Gibbs D. Barham, Sampson, Daniel and supposed to contain about
fifty acres of Land for him the said William & Wilson. To have and to
hold their said interest in and to the said Lands described as aforesaid to
the said William & Wilson and to his heirs and assigns forever for and in
manner of claims or claims of them the said Benjamin Worrell and Nancy his
wife also their heirs and assigns forever. To the only proper use and behoof of him the
said William & Wilson his heirs and assigns which he do by these presents to
warrant and defend against ourselves and our heirs and assigns, and also against
all and every person and persons whomsoever. And We hereby Whosoever
each of us have here set our hands and affixed our seals, the day and
