This Indenture made the 24th of September 1847. by and between Robert Williams of the first part Robert Williams of the second part and Edmund Williams of the third part: Whereas the said Robert Williams is justly indebted to the said Edmund Williams in the sum of forty two dollars and twenty cents appearing by bill as well as this Indenture payable on demand and of new date herewith which debt with the legal interest thereon concerning the said Robert Williams is willing and desirous to remit: Now This Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the said Robert Williams or in hand paid by the said Robt. Williams for at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Robert Williams and his heirs grant and bargain and sell and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto him the said Robert Williams for his heirs and assigns forever the following named property to wit: Ten acres of land also about fifteen acres more or less, cart and pair cart wheels and the present standing crop of corn fodder peas potatoes cotton &c with all the right title interest and estate of us and to the above described property and its future increase which he the said Robert Williams and his heirs have had and hold in and to each and all of the before named and above said property and every part and parcel thereof unto him the said Robt. Williams for his heirs Executors and assigns forever and the said Robt. Williams and for himself his heirs Executors and administrators do hereby Covenant promise and agree to and with the said Robt. Williams for his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever in manner and form following that is to say: that he the said Robert Williams unto his heirs Executors or administrators the before named and above said property and its future increase hereby conveyed unto him the said Robt. Williams for his Executors administrators and assigns against all persons whatsoever shall well warrant and forever defend by these presents: It is further agreed that the said Robt. Williams for his Executors and administrators shall permit the said Robert Williams and his heirs Executors or administrators to remain in quiet possession of the above named property and every part thereof so long and as long as he the said Edmund Williams his Executors or administrators desire it fit or proper for him the said Robt. Williams and his heirs such possession and to long as at which time by the said Edmund Williams his Executors administrators give the said Robt. Williams for his heirs heirs in writing to sell or much or all of the above named and above said property as will be sufficient to pay the said debt and the accrued interest thereon and also all costs incurred in any way by the full execution of the trust first giving the
