Therefore this Indenture Witnesseth that the said John P. Hines in consideration of the premises as well as for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to him by the said William & Robert Lillman paid the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has granted bargained and sold by these presents to grant bargain and sell unto the said William & Robert Lillman his executors and assigns the following property to wit: all his the said Hines household & kitchen furniture his stock of hogs future increase thereof his crop of corn future increase potatoes &c. made this present year & his new garden in which may be standing in the field his farming utensils: To have and to hold the said property unto him the said William & Robert Lillman his executors and assigns upon Trust however that at any time hereafter when he shall request the said William & Robert Lillman it shall be the duty of the said William & Robert Lillman to make sale of the property aforesaid at public auction for cash and give adequate public notice of the time and place of sale and out of the money arising from such sale pay all expenses attending the sale then pay and satisfy the debt due the said William & Robert Lillman if any pay was to the said Hines.
