This Indenture made this 3rd day of October 1841 between Alexander Stewart of the first part Wm. W. Briggs of the second part and G. S. Williams Clerk & Paper, Esq^r of B. B. Ham and Robert Taylor of the third part, the said Alexander Stewart is jointly indebted to the said G. S. Williams in the sum of twenty three dollars & 66²/₃ to Clark & Doper in the sum of five dollars & 66²/₃ cents, to Joseph S. B. Ham in the sum of five dollars & 66²/₃ to John H. B. Ham in the sum of twelve dollars, and to Robert Taylor in the sum of twelve dollars. And it is agreed
 Alexander Stewart being willing and desirous to secure the payment of his above named debt to have agreed to convey his property herein after described unto the said Wm. W. Briggs in trust to be sold for that purpose. This Indenture witnesseth that the said Alexander Stewart promises Consideration of the premises as well as for other further Consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Wm. W. Briggs Receipt to him by acknowledging said granted Bargain and sale unto the said Wm. W. Briggs the following property to wit: one fourth of the crop of Corn, fodder and grass growing on the lands of my wife: and one half of the crop of Corn, fodder and grass growing on the land of Robert Taylor unto the said Wm. W. Briggs his heirs etc: Upon Trust Reciting that the said Wm. W. Briggs shall at any time hereafter upon being required by either of parties of the third part set up and sell the above named Crop of Corn, fodder and grass to the highest bidder for cash, after having advertised the time and place of sale and out of the monies arising from sale first pay all expenses attending this trust then pay the debts that stand unto the balances if any pay to the said Alexander Stewart or his heirs or assigns: And witnesseth further that the parties hereto have executed at their hands & seal this day date above written
