This Indenture made this 3rd day of October 1849. between Alexander
 Stewart of the first part, Wm W Briggs of the second part and J S Williams
 Clerk & Depts, Esps J P Barham and Robert Taylor of the third part; Whereas
 the said Alexander Stewart is justly indebted to the said J S Williams
 in the sum of twenty three dollars & 66^{cs} to Clerk & Depts in the sum of
 five dollars & 66^{cs} to Esps J P Barham in the sum of five dollars and
 50^{cs} and to Robt Taylor in the sum of twelve dollars; and the said
 Alexander Stewart being willing and desirous to secure the payment of the
 aforesaid debt to have agreed to convey the property hereinafter men-
 tioned unto the said Wm W Briggs in trust to be sold for that purpose and
 this Indenture witnesseth that the said Alexander Stewart for and
 consideration of the premises as well as for the further consideration of
 the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Wm W Briggs the
 Receipt is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained and sold unto the
 said Wm W Briggs the following property to wit: one fourth of the crop of
 corn fodder and peas now growing in the lands of my wife; and one half
 of the crop of corn fodder & peas growing on the land of Robt Taylor
 unto the said Wm W Briggs his heirs &c. Upon Trust, nevertheless
 that the said Wm W Briggs shall at any time hereafter upon being agreed
 by either of parties of the third part set up and sell the aforesaid
 crop of corn fodder and peas to the highest bidder for cash, after having
 advertised the time and place of sale and out of the Monies arising from
 sale first pay all expenses attending this trust then pay the debt aforesaid
 and the balance if any pay to the said A Stewart or his heirs &c.
