This Indenture made the 20<sup>th</sup> day of September Eighteen hundred and  
 between B. B. Barrett of the first part James Magrath of the second  
 and Margaret D. Barrett all of the County of Southampton and the  
 of Virginia of the third part: Witnesseth that the said Benj<sup>n</sup> Barrett  
 in order to secure the payment of the following debts to wit, one bond  
 payable to said Margaret D. Barrett for the sum of two hundred fifty  
 dollars & twenty three cents dated the day, 20<sup>th</sup> of September 1849 a bond  
 bond due the said Margaret D. Barrett for the sum of two hundred  
 twenty dollars dated 20 of Sep 1849 and in consideration for the sum  
 of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said James Magrath as or  
 before the making and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof  
 is hereby acknowledged by the said Benj<sup>n</sup> Barrett he do hereby  
 & sell and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said  
 Magrath all his interest in the tract of Land withed to him by his late  
 Father John Barrett whereas the said Barrett lived & died and the great  
 and other Real Estate and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof  
 and all the right, title, interest trust, property claim and demand, whatsoever  
 both at Law and equity of him the said Benj<sup>n</sup> Barrett in and to the said  
 Land and Tenements: To have and to hold the said herein before mentioned  
 tract of Land with the appurtenances unto the said James Magrath his heirs  
 Executors administrators and assigns forever: Upon Trust nevertheless  
 the said James Magrath immediately upon the request of the said Margaret  
 D. Barrett or her Administrator or Executor shall after having advertised the  
 time and place of sale of the said property or Land at least twenty day  
 previous to the day of sale at three public places in said County aforesaid  
 to sell the same to the highest bidder for Cash: and out of the moneys  
 arising from the sale in the first place pay and satisfy all reasonable  
 Charges attending the sale and the debts herein mentioned and the  
 residue of Money arising from such sale as aforesaid to the use of the  
 said Benj<sup>n</sup> Barrett his Executor Administrator or assigns: Notwithstanding
