

This Indenture made the 15th day of September 1849 between John Vicks and wife Polly and James Vicks who has at deed of Trust and Jesse B. Vicks is broker of the one part; and Benjamin F. Vicks and Daniel Vicks of the other part; all of the County of Southampton and State of Va. Whereas the said John Vicks and wife James Vicks and Jesse B. Vicks in consideration of the sum of sixty dollars lawful money of Va. to them in hand paid by the said Benjamin Vicks and Daniel Vicks at & before the making and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said Benjamin F. Vicks and Daniel Vicks their heirs, and assigns forever one certain tract of Land with the appurtenances situated lying and being in the County of Southampton and Parish of Rotherham and bounded as follows, to wit by black Creek East by Daniel Diggins Land South by William Diggins Land West by Dr. Robt. S. Diggins Land containing by survey Sixty five acres more or less we convey unto Benj. Vicks & D. Vicks their heirs forever all right and title to the same or any part thereof: To have and to hold the sd tract of Land with the appurtenances before described unto and all and singular the premises intended to be bargained and sold unto the said Benj. F. Vicks and Daniel Vicks to them and their heirs forever. Said John Vicks and wife James Vicks and Jesse B. This Indenture made and entered into the 23rd day of April in the year of our last Christ one thousand eight hundred and forty nine between Caroline Bulle of the County of Southampton and Rotherham parish of the one part and William Diggins of the same County and parish of the other part: Whereas the said Caroline Bulle for and in consideration of the sum of twenty seven dollars in hand paid by the said William Diggins the Receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have granted, bargained and sold and conveyed unto the said William Diggins his heirs and assigns forever, a certain tract or parcel of Land containing or estimated further more to the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a post oak in Mary Vicks and Richard H. Calcoms line thence along of Murchell line to a pine in said Vicks and Calcoms line thence along a line of Murchell line to a pine in said Calcoms line thence along said Calcoms line to a dogwood in said Calcoms line; thence along said Calcoms line to the first corner of the tract of Land which the said Caroline Bulle inherited by the death of her father Jesse Bulle together with all the appurtenances aforesaid
