This INDENTURE made and entered into this 21st day of October A.D. 1844 between Marshal B. Rochelle of the one part and John M. Gurley of the other: Whereas James Rochelle deceased died by his last Will and Testament of Record in the Clerks Office of Suffolk County aforesaid Marshal B. Rochelle his wife, and Executrix to sell certain tracts or parcels of Land belonging to his Estate for the purpose of paying his debts and among others a certain parcel or tract of Land lying on the South side of Nettaway River near the Chick Rock bridge containing about eighty acres and being legal and valid Conveyances for the same: Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to the said Marshal B. Rochelle in hand paid by the said John M. Gurley before the sealing and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Marshal B. Rochelle has given granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell unto the said John M. Gurley a tract of Land lying on the South side of Nettaway River near Chick Rock bridge containing about eighty acres of the same more or less: It is agreed and to hold the said tract of Land together with all its appurtenances unto him the said John M. Gurley and his heirs forever: And the said Marshal B. Rochelle doth hereby covenant and agree for himself his heirs etc to and with the said John M. Gurley his heirs and his title unto the said tract of Land together with all its appurtenances free to warrant and defend against all and every person whatsoever: In Testimony whereof she her burgundy set her hand and affixed her seal the day and year above mentioned.
