

Know all men by these presents that We Henry Kinderd and Lucy B Kinderd of the State of Virginia and County of Southampton, for and in consideration of the Natural love and affection which we bear to John J Kinderd of the same State and County, as well as for the further consideration of one dollar to us in hand paid by the said John J Kinderd at and before the making and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said John J Kinderd his Executors administrators and assigns all that Land lying as follows, to wit: fifty acres cut off by running a straight line from a point on the Boykins bridge Road to the ~~Boyskins~~ ^{Boyskins} Creek, thence down the run of the Creek, to the Lands of George B Casey, thence up the said George B Casey line to the said Boyskins bridge Road, thence along the said Road to the point at which this line begins: To Have and to hold the said Land together with all the rights appurtenances & hereditaments therunto belonging unto him the said John J Kinderd, his Executors administrators and assigns forever: And the said Henry Kinderd and Lucy B Kinderd for themselves, their heirs Executors administrators and assigns, the said parcel of Land with all its appurtenances, unto the said John J Kinderd, his Executors administrators and assigns against the claim of them the said Henry Kinderd and Lucy B Kinderd, his wife and against the claims of all persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend them by these presents: In Witness whereof they have hereunto affixed their hands & seal this 24th October 1847.
