This INDEBTEDNESS made this 25th day of Sept 1849 between Edward
Bradshaw & Mary his wife of the one part, & Littleton R. Edwards of the other
part. Sam'l Kello, Willis Bradshaw & Richard H. Branch of the third part,
all of the County of Hampshire: witnesseth that whereas the said Brad-
shaw & Willis Bradshaw stand bound as security for the said Edwards
Bradshaw to a bond executed by the said W. Bradshaw & said Kello & Brad-
shaw his securities to Joseph Dillies for the sum of one thousand dollars
of 1841, and furthermore the said Edwin Bradshaw stands justly
indebted to the said Kello, in the sum of Sixty Nine dollars and fifty
cents by bond due the 16th day of July 1847: as also the said Bradshaw
stands justly indebted to the said Richard H. Branch in the sum of sixty
Nine dollars and fifty cents by bond due the 16th day of July 1847, and
for the assuring and securing the said Sam'l Kello & Willis Bradshaw
from all harm or damage that may or can arise in their security upon
said and also to secure the payment of the aforesaid bonds and Interest
the said Sam'l Kello and Richard H. Branch a ^{short} Conveyance shall be made
to the said Littleton R. Edwards for the benefit of the said Kello, Bradshaw
& Branch. Now this Indebtedness therefore witnesseth that the said Ed-
ward Bradshaw for and in consideration of promises aforesaid as well as for the further
consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Littleton
R. Edwards the Receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge have granted
Bargain and solet and by these presents do grant Bargain and solet unto
the said Littleton R. Edwards his assigns &c. one tract of Land with the
houses and appurtenances thereunto belonging and the following property to wit:
1 house 30 broad of logs 8 Cattle, 50 barrels Corn 3000 lbs feed 3 pecks
books & furniture 15 chairs 1 table 1 Snow cart and wheels big & horns
& harness & pole 20 pens 3 plough bars and 3 axes: To have and to hold
the said tract of Land and property unto him the said Littleton R. Edwards
his heirs & assigns forever: UPON TRUST & KNOWLEDGE that the said Edwin
Bradshaw is to retain possession until the said Kello Bradshaw or Branch
or their executors or assigns shall direct the said Littleton R. Edwards
or his executors to take possession of the same and duly advertising the
same and places of sale for two days the said Littleton R. Edwards as trustee
shall sell the said tract of Land & to much of the other property mentioned
as may be necessary to satisfy all the debts above mentioned with Interest
thereon according to the highest bidder for cash and of the proceeds of such sale
pay first the expenses of the trust & then the debts aforesaid with the ~~the~~ ^{the} debts
they have accrued interest and the balance if any pay to the said Edwin
Bradshaw or his wife: but if the said Edwin Bradshaw shall will and jointly
pay the aforesaid debts when they may be demanded, know the ^{the} ~~the~~
trustee: 2000 Dollars wherof the parties have herunto set their hands and
