 and sold and by their promise do give grant bargain and sell unto
 the said Richard H Baker Sr, his heirs and assigns a certain tract
 or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton
 at or neare Black Water River being the same which was purchased by
 the said Richard H Baker of James Gardner and Betty his wife
 by Deeds bearing date the 30th day of January 1836 and of Record
 in the County of Southampton: and bounded as in said Deeds does
 contain and hundred and thirty two and a half acres
 more or less: To have and to hold the said parcel or tract of
 Land with its premises and appurtenances unto the said Richard
 H Baker Sr, his heirs and assigns forever: and the said Richard
 H Baker & Eliza A his wife for themselves and their heirs the said
 tract or parcel of Land with all and singular the premises and
 appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Richard H Baker & his
 heirs and assigns for ever the claim or claims of them the said Richard
 H Baker and Eliza A his wife or either of them their or either of their
 heirs and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall well
 and do warrant and forever defend by their privies: And Witnesseth
 that the said Richard H Baker and Eliza his wife have hereunto set their hands
