of Virginia: Witness Whereas the said Nathⁿ Simmons on the 20th day of
May 1848, in order to secure the payment of the sum of five hundred
Dollars with lawful interest thereon from the day last aforesaid to the
said Henry Kindred and Mark S Dole at bond due the 15th day of March
1848 of six hundred Dollars with lawful interest thereon due by Indenture
bore of that date coming to the said Benjamin & Dope and his heirs
two certain Negro Slaves to wit "one Negro boy named Jacob and one
Negro Girl named Winney and her future increase" upon certain trust
therein mentioned as by reference to the said deed of Record in the
Clerk's Office of said County will more fully appear: and Whereas
since the execution of this Trust the said Nathⁿ Simmons hath fully
satisfied and paid to the said Henry Kindred and Mark S Dole the
debt thereby intended to be secured which payment the said Kindred
and Dole doth hereby acknowledge: Now This Indenture Witness
eth that in consideration of the premises and for the further consideration
of one dollar in hand paid by the said Simmons to the said Dope at and
before the executing and delivery of these presents the Receipt of which
the said sum of one dollar is hereby acknowledged by the said Benjamin
& Dope with the approbation and consent of the said Henry Kindred
and Mark S Dole attested by their being parties to these presents, and
the said Mark S Dole do by these presents grant bargain sell release
and confirm unto the said Nathⁿ Simmons and his heirs forever all the
estate right title interest both in Law and equity which the said Dope
and said Kindred and Dole have and possess in and to the said two Negro
Slaves conveyed by the deed of Trust aforesaid: To have and to hold
the said two Negro Slaves to him the said Nathⁿ Simmons and his heirs
forever: and the said Dope Kindred and Dole for themselves and their heirs
respectfully do severally covenant with the said Simmons his heirs & assigns
that they the said Dope Kindred and Dole and their respective heirs shall and
will forever warrant and defend the title of the aforesaid Negro Slaves to the
said Simmons and his heirs and assigns against the claims of themselves
respectively and of all and every person claiming by through or under them
or either of them but against the claims of no other person whatsoever.
