This Indenture made and entered into this 15th day of
November in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty nine
between Francis M. Boykin of the County of Giles of right of the
one part, and Suddow Lawrence of the County of Southampton of the
other part all of the State of Virginia: Witnesseth that the said
Francis M. Boykin for and in consideration of the sum of sixteen hun-
dred Dollars to him in hand paid by the said Suddow Lawrence
at or before the executing or delivery of these presents, the Receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged, hath granted bargain'd and sold unto the said Suddow Lawrence
his heirs and assigns forever, a certain tract of Land in the County of said
ampton containing by estimation seven hundred acres, be the same more
or less. This Tract embraces what is usually called the Danish, Dogleg and
and Whitney, also a certain Water Grift Mill commonly called
Ballards and one hundred and twenty acres of Land attached thereto
be the same more or less. During the Natural life of Francis Wilson
and at his death then to only one half of said Water Grift Mill
and Land attached thereto forever, to have and to hold the

thereto with all and singular the premises profits and advantages
