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This Indenture made and entered into the 30<sup>th</sup> day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & forty nine: between William Bradsheaw and Julia his wife of the one part, and Johnson Barnes of the other part: all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia: Witnesseth that the said William Bradsheaw & Julia his wife for and in consideration of the sum of eighty Dollars lawful money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid or secured to be paid at or before the executing and delivery of these presents by the said Johnson Barnes the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Johnson Barnes his heirs & assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of Land with all & singular the appurtenances situate lying and being in the County aforesaid containing twenty acres more or less and hundredths follows to wit: Beginning at a pine on the said side of said Bradsheaw's former field, and running in a direct line with said field to the land now belonging to Irvine Griffin thence down the said Griffin line to the main run of the Mill Swamp, thence up said Swamp, until it comes in a direct line with the beginning, forming an oblong shape: To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with the Tenements, hereditaments and all and singular other the premises & appurtenances mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof unto him the said Johnson Barnes his heirs & assigns forever: and the said William Bradsheaw & Julia his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Johnson Barnes his heirs & assigns, free from the Claims or Claims of them the said William Bradsheaw & Julia his wife or their heirs, and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall will and doth warrant and forever defend by these presents: In Witness whereof the said William Bradsheaw and Julia his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first above written.
