

This Indenture made and entered into this 30th day of October in the year of our Lord eight hundred and forty seven: William I. Rodgprick of the one part: and Marisha Bullle his wife of the other part: all of the County of Southampton: Witnesseth that the said William I. Rodgprick for and in consideration of the sum of Six hundred and fifty Dollars lawfull money of this Kingdom available to them in hand paid or to be paid at or before the receiving and delivery of the premises by the said Wm I Rodgprick the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has bargained and sold unto the said Marisha Bullle his wife and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of Land with all and singular the appurtenances situate lying and being in the County aforesaid containing by estimation two hundred and four acres more or less and bounded by the Lands of William Bradshaw Wm B. Jagger, Oliver Whitefield James Innes & Richard Kabanah: To have unto the said Marisha Bullle his wife and assigns forever the same tract or parcel of Land with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular other the premises & appurtenances therein or included to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof unto him the said Wm I Rodgprick his heirs and assigns forever: And the said William I. Rodgprick his heirs and assigns forever and their heirs the said Tract of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said William I Rodgprick his heirs and assigns forever from the claim or claims of them the said William Bullle & Marisha his wife or their heirs & of all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall will and doth warrant & forever defend by their persons the said William Bullle & Marisha his wife have heretofore at their hands & affirmed their seals the day and date first above written
