This Indenture made and entered into this 6th day of April one thousand eight hundred and forty nine between Charlotte Bryant of the County of Southampton of the one part: and Tom Crocker (free Negro) of the County aforesaid of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Charlotte Bryant for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and sixty four dollars and 33¹/₂ Cents in hand paid by the said Tom Crocker the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged both Bargainers sold and by their mutual covenants bargain sell a line in fee simple and confirm unto the said Tom Crocker his heirs and assigns one tract or parcel of Land situated lying in the County of Southampton aforesaid containing by survey forty one and 1/2 acres and bounded as follows to wit: Beginning in the Indian Road at a new corner for said Charlotte Bryant in Benjamin Sands line line thence along said Sands line of Marked trees thence to a white Oak thence to a black gum tree branch thence to a pine thence to another pine thence to a pine at corner for said Sands line in Colonel Ridgely line thence along his line to a pine thence to a dead black oak thence to a white Oak thence to a pine at new corner for said Charlotte Bryant in Col^l Ridgely line thence to the new line to the said Indian Road thence along the said Road to the beginning: To have and to hold the said piece or parcel of Land with all the privileges appurtenances and profits thereunto belonging, and all the rights interest claims and demands of the said Charlotte Bryant my heirs and assigns forever to the said tract or parcel of Land unto the said Tom Crocker and his heirs and assigns forever to warrant and defend the aforesaid right title against the claims or claims of every person whatsoever: In Witness whereof I the said Charlotte Bryant has set my hand and affixed my seal this day and date as above written
