

Know all men by these presents that we James Holman, Care Bowers and hold and firmly bound unto the President, and Directors of the Savings Fund and their Successors in Office in the just and full sum of one thousand Dollars to which payment well and truly to be made to the said President, and Directors of the Savings Fund and their Successors in Office we bind ourselves and our heirs Executors and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 17th day of December 1847.

The Conditions of the above obligation is such that whereas James Holman was on the 15th day of October 1847, by the School Commissioners in and for the County of Southampton appointed their Treasurer for the year ending on the 31st December 1848. Now if the said James Holman shall faithfully apply and account for all moneys which may come to his hands by virtue of his Office and shall perform and transact all and every act and thing appertaining to his said Office according to Law: then the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.

Stephenson at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold a bond, with force and effect and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto and assign forever all the interest they the said Matthew Bull and Elizabeth Bull formerly Baykin his wife hold and shall be entitled to at the death of the testator in the estate of the late John Cook Baykin dead and of whom the said parties are heirs and devisees in the lands and mill and well and house as Baykin was entitled in the Estate of the said Nathaniel Baykin: To have and to hold the said Nammet property and all the interest with the said Stephenson his heirs and assigns forever, and unto the said William R.
