This indenture made the 17th day
of December in the year of our Lord 1844 between John Cobb of the one part,
and William A. Rollings of the other. Witnesseth that the said John
Cobb in consideration of one hundred and fifty dollars of lawful
money of this Commonwealth, the Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge
and do by these presents give grants bargain sell and Convey unto the
said William A. Rollings his heirs and assigns all certain parcel of
Land situated in the County of前述 Containing one hundred acres
more or less bounded and described as follows: Out the North by the said
William A. Rollings Land, and the east by the Cobham Road, and
the south by White Mill pond, and on the West by the Main Run
of the Indian Branch (at prong of the mill pond) together with all
the privileges and appurtenances of the said Land in anywise appur-
tenant and belonging. To have and to hold the above granted premi-
ses to the said William A. Rollings his heirs and assigns to his and
their use and benefit forever and to the said John Cobb for myself
my heirs Executors and Administrators do Convey, with the said
William A. Rollings his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized
in fee of the aforesaid premises, that they are free from all incum-
brance, that I have good right to sell and Convey the same to the said
William A. Rollings as aforesaid; and that I will and my heirs
and Executors and Administrators shall warrant and defend the same
to the said William A. Rollings his heirs and assigns forever against the
lawful demands of all persons. Attestments whereof I the said
John Cobb have hereunto set my hand and seal this 17th day of Decem-
ber in the year of our Lord 1844.
