The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above boundent Alexander Myrick is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a Commission from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the 15<sup>th</sup> day of December 1849. To take effect from the expiration of the term of the present Sheriff and to continue his Office until the first quarterly Court to be holden for the said County in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty one: If therefore the said Alexander Myrick shall well and truly collect all dues poor rates and account for and pay the same in such manner as is by Law directed and also all fees for services and amercements according to the Commonwealthe in the said County and shall duly account for and pay the same to the Exchequer of the Commonwealth for the time being for the use of the Commonwealth in the manner as is or shall be directed in case of public taxes and shall in all things truly and faithfully execute the said Office of Sheriff during his continuance therein than the above
