 by the said John Bachman at or before the sealing and delivery of these
 presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John A Bryant
 his heirs and assigns and sold and by these presents the said John A Bryant
 his heirs and assigns doth sell to the said John Bachman his heirs and assigns forever the
 following property to wit: all and several houses, out doors, trees, trees tract of
 hay and their future increase, all of his household and kitchen furniture
 farming utensils &c. Thirty barrels of corn set or other stacks of fodder
 shucked and one thousand pounds salt pork. To have and to hold to his the
 said John Bachman proper use and behoof upon Trust, nevertheless the
 said John Bachman shall at the request of either one of the aforesaid parties
 after giving at least ten days notice of the time and place of sale sell at public
 auction for cash all the aforesaid property, or so much thereof as shall be
 sufficient to satisfy the aforesaid debts interest and cost and out of the
 proceeds first pay the expenses thereof, then pay the debt due D. C. D. B.
 Pope then pay the debt due Harrison & Pope, and the balance if any
 pay over to the said John A Bryant, or his legal Representatives and the
 said John A Bryant covenants with the said John Bachman that his
 possession of and absolute for simple right to sell the property hereby conveyed
 and that he will forever warrant and defend the same against himself
