This Indenture made and entered into this the first day January  
one thousand eight hundred and fifty between Patience Vicke of the one part  
Nathan B. Bryant of the second part and Edward Brant of the third  
part witnesseth that whereas the said Patience Vicke stands justly imbt  
to the said Edward Brant in the sum of Nine hundred and fifty six  
dollars and twenty cents due by indenture Note on the first day of January  
1850 and being desirous to secure the payment thereof back bound in considera  
tion of the premises as well as for the further consideration of the sum of  
one dollar to her in hand paid by the said Nathan B. Bryant for  
gained and sold aforesaid unfeoffed until Conformit and by these presents  
doth grant bargain and sell aforesaid unfeoffed until Conformit unto the said Nathan  
B. Bryant his heirs Executors administrators and assigns the following proper  
ty to wit: At certain tract or parcel of land lying and lying and being  
in the County of Southampton containing by estimation two hundred and fifty  
acres more or less bounded as follows to wit East by Thomas B. Darrow  
South by Robert B. Bassett West by John Caryow Josiah Vicke North by  
Jane Holt and Joshua Vicke also one hundred six Windsor chairs fourteen  
hundred of sheep one blue chest six barrels of Crisole townland head of hou  
sehold tools household and furniture to have and to hold the aforesaid  
tract or parcel of land and premises together with the aforesaid personal prop  
erty unto him the said Nathan B. Bryant his heirs Executors administrators  
for the following tract and purposes that is to say that if the said Patience  
Vicke shall fail to pay unto the said Edward Brant the debt aforesaid due  
him with interest which may accrue thereon or any part of the same  
and interest when demanded it shall and may be lawful for the said Nathan B.  
Bryant or in case of his death for his legal personal Representative who is  
lawfully authorized to act upon him which aforesaid by the said Edward Brant  
his Executors administrators or assigns to make sale of the property aforesaid for  
cash having given at least ten days previous notice of the time and place  
and met of lot money arising therefrom first pay and satisfy the debt and  
interest aforesaid or so much thereof as may be due at the time and the  
costs and expenses attending such sale and this conveyance and the balance  
if any pay over to the said Patience Vicke her wife or legal personal Representa  
tive but if the said Patience Vicke shall well and truly pay and discharge the
