This Deed of Trust between Patience Vick of the first part, & J. B. Bryan of the second part, and Edward Bonfont of the third part, proved by the oaths of the subscribing witnesses and admitted to Record.

This Indenture made and entered into this twentieth day of January in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty, between E. B. Clout and Joseph H. Prince Executors of the last will and Testament of Benjamin Williamson, dec'd of the first part; and Peter Edwards of the County of Southampton of the second part; whereof the said Testator in his last will aforesaid which was duly admitted to probate, and of Record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County Court amongst other things devised that his Executors do sell all the balance of my Estate both real and personal and whereas the above named E. B. Clout and Joseph H. Prince the Executors appointed by the said will duly qualified, as such and in execution of the power conferred on them after duly complying with the provision of the said will have sold at public auction to the said Edwards all that portion of the Lands of said Testator known as the Barron Tract contained within the lines and bounds hereinafter set forth at one dollar and fifty cents per acre; This Indenture therefore witnesseth that for and in consideration of the promise and of the sum of three hundred sixty eight Dollars and twenty seven cents to them to be paid in two equal annual instalments by the said Peter Edwards they the said E. B. Clout and Joseph H. Prince as aforesaid have granted, sold and conveyed unto the said Edwards all that tract or parcel of Land whereof the said Benj. Williamson dec'd possessed and four hundred eighty six one fourth acre be the same more or less and bounded by the Land of said Edwards, Revis Harris & Benj. C. Carter to Mark S. Porter, To have and to hold the said granted premises with the appurtenances to him the said Peter Edwards, and his heirs forever; And the said E. B. Clout and Joseph H. Prince Executors as aforesaid covenants with the said Peter Edwards that he shall have possession with a good title to the said granted premises free from the claims of the said Clout and Prince and of aforesaid and all other persons claiming by or through them or their aforesaid or by or through their said Testator.
