due by bond, bearing date with these presents: And Whereas the said
Charles Bryant is desirous to secure and had he agreed to secure the payment
of the said debt, and interest, with all charges attending the same, in or
by means of the premises by conveying the property herein specified
unto the said William R. Edwards his heirs: Upon Trust: Now
Therefore this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Charles Bryant
in consideration of the premises and of the sum of one dollar to be by the
said Bryant in hand paid the Receipt Whereof is hereby acknowledged,
has here bargained and sold, confirmed, assigned and made over, and sold by
these presents bargain and sell confirmed assign and make over unto the said
William R. Edwards, one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being
in the County of Southampton, containing by estimation right hundred and
two in the same more or less is being the same tract of land whereon the said
Bryant now resides with its appurtenances thereto belonging: Also the
following Negro slaves to wit: Matt Bray, Matt Selmon and Wm. A.
Mims and the future increase of the female with the said William R.
Edwards to, In favor and to hold the aforesaid tract of land and Negro
slaves above mentioned unto the said William R. Edwards his heirs
