

This Indenture made and entered into this 25th day of January in the year
 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty, between Joseph Helms of this
 part, Dein Griffis of the second part, and Milton D. Butler of the third part,
 all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia; witnesseth that the
 said Joseph Helms for and in Consideration of the sum of one hundred Fifty
 Dollars which said sum is due from the said Joseph Helms to the said Milton
 D. Butler by bond bearing date the 25th day of January one thousand eight
 hundred and fifty; as well as all other monies which may be due and owing
 from the said Joseph Helms to the said Milton D. Butler by means of any
 dealings transfer of debts or paper whatever as also for and in Consideration of
 one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Dein Griffis, the Recipient whereof
 the said Joseph Helms doth hereby acknowledge, hath granted bargained and
 sold, and by these presents doth hereby grant, bargains and sell convey and
 make over unto the said Dein Griffis and his heirs forever all his rights
 and interests in following property to wit: All of that tract of parcel of
 land whereon the said Joseph Helms now resides containing by estimation
 four hundred and Twenty acres more or less bounded as follows on the
 North by the lands of John Hines, on the South by the lands of Edwards
 Butler & Willis Williams, to East by Peter Booth, on the West by the lands
 of Edwin Travis, also one vine brick house one small Moore cloth six head of
 cattle with household and kitchen furniture of every description belonging
 to him the said Joseph Helms. To have and to hold with all the rights
 and interests of the said Joseph Helms herein conveyed or intended to be conveyed
 to him the said Dein Griffis his heirs and assigns forever upon this special trust
 heretofore that the said Dein Griffis upon being a sale required by the said
 Milton D. Butler shall proceed to sell all the rights and interests of the said
 Joseph Helms to the above named tract of Land & either property hereby conveyed
 or intended to be conveyed after advertising the same and place in the said County
 of Southampton for ten days previous at some public house or store for credit and
 out of the money arising out or from the said sale, in the first place pay and
 satisfy all cost attending the said sale as well as the expense advertising the
 said Conveyance and then pay off the bond aforesaid with interest; as well as
 all other monies which may appear to be due and owing from the said Joseph Helms
 to the said Milton D. Butler by means of any dealings transfer of debts or paper
 whatever, and the surplus if any pay to the said Joseph Helms: and the said
 Joseph Helms for himself his heirs executors and administrators, his wife, and
 all of the said tract of land and other property, and the said Dein Griffis
 his heirs and assigns forever, shall bear by warrant and defend against, the lawful
 claim or claims of him the said Joseph Helms his heirs executors and administrators
 and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever: and the said
 Dein Griffis and his part covenants and agrees that he will make sale of the
 rights and interests hereby conveyed for the best price he can obtain for the same
 after advertising the same and place for ten days previous at some public house
 or store in the said County: and with the monies arising from the said first pay
 and satisfy all cost attending the same as well as the expense advertising the
 Conveyance, and then pay off the aforesaid bond and interest as well as all
 other monies which may appear to the said Dein Griffis to be justly due and
 owing from the said Joseph Helms to the said Milton D. Butler by means of
