 Boylt at or before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said William D Flour and Nancy
 his wife have granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and
 by these presents do hereby grant bargain sell alien convey and confirm unto
 the said Rudolph Boylt his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract of land
 with the appurtenances situated lying in the County of Southampton containing
 one hundred & thirty nine acres in the same more or less bounded as follows
