

interlocutory Decree, made and entered in the County Court, of Southampton at the October Term 1848 and at Court Table depending in said Court, whereat it was decreed and ordered that Joseph J. Lawrence, Wm. Jones and Meredith Holland after giving thirty days notice of the time and place of sale should expose to public sale on a credit of six months, the several tracts of Land lying in Southampton County, Virginia, James D. Moore died seized & possessed, though the Dowry might of his Will. Margaret Moore surviving as dower in cash sufficient to defray the necessary expenses, and after deducting the same from the amount of sale, to take bonds for the balance as by said decree directed; and whereas in pursuance of said decree, the said Commissioners did on the 23rd day of November 1848 expose to public sale the Tract of Land, called the "old place tract" and conveyed thence the Deed of said Tract book said to contain two hundred & seventy five acres more or less being of the time and place of sale having been given in conformity to said Decree, when Wm. D. Moore became the last bidder and purchaser for the sum of five hundred and sixty two Dollars, This Deed being referred further to wit: that the said Joseph J. Lawrence Wm. Jones and Meredith Holland Commissioners as aforesaid as well as for and in consideration of the promissory note of the sum of one Dollar to them in hand parcel by the said Wm. D. Moore they the said Commissioners aforesaid hath granted, bargained, sold, and by their power, do grant bargain and sell unto the said Wm. D. Moore his heirs and assigns the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land before mentioned and described and which was sold at public auction aforesaid; To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Wm. D. Moore his heirs and assigns against the claim or claims demand or demands of whom he and Joseph J. Lawrence Wm. Jones and Meredith Holland their heirs or assigns or either of them, shall will, and do warrant and defend by virtue of the decree aforesaid and in more In Testimony Whereof the said Joseph J. Lawrence Wm. Jones and Meredith Holland Commissioners aforesaid have hereunto set their hands and seals the day & year as forth above written
