Land unto the said Dick R Strong his heirs and assigns free from all claim
of him the said Billethorn R Edwards, his heirs and of all and every other
person or persons whatsoever shall well and truly forever warrant and defend
by these presents. And the said Dick R Strong for himself his heirs and
assigns. Executors and administrators, and for every of them, doth covenant
and agree with the said Billethorn R Edwards his heirs and assigns, and to
and with each of them by these presents, that he the said Dick R Strong his
heirs and assigns will at all times without hindrance or molestation grant
permits and allow to the owners and occupiers of that part of the Milliken
Track on which the Mansion house is situated the free use of the Well situated
to and the parcel of Land hereby conveyed, with the right of way thence
and therefrom in the shortest and most convenient direction for their said
owners and occupiers and the said Dick R Strong for himself his heirs
and assigns. Executors and administrators doth further covenant and agree
with the said Billethorn R Edwards his heirs and assigns, that he the said
Dick R Strong his heirs and assigns will jointly with the owners and
occupiers of the said part of the Milliken Track on which the Mansion
house is situated, keep the said Well in good repair and that neither he
nor his heirs or assigns will by digging another Well, or in any other way
