Witnesseth that the said Silvestor R Edwards for and in consideration of the
sum of one hundred and twenty Dollars to him in hand paid by the said
Harrison D Moore the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, and
sold and do by these presents grant bargain sell transfer and convey unto him
the said Moore his heirs and assigns at certain price or parcel of Land lying
near Jerusalem and bounded as follows to wit; by the Road leading from Jerusalem
to Rogers bridge on the North by the Road leading from Jerusalem to the
Opposite bridge on the East by the by the Land of the Estate of James
Rockwell on the South by the Land of said Moore on the West; it being
a part of the Milliken State of Land, and contains about twenty six acres
or the same more or less; To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of
Land to premises with its appurtenances unto him the said Harrison D Moore
his heirs & assigns forever; and the said Edwards covenants with the said
Moore that he is possessed of an Estate of free simple in the premises above
described, and that he will warrant & defend the same unto him the said
Moore his heirs and assigns against himself the said Edwards and every one his
