This Indenture made and entered into this eighteenth day of February 1849
between Jazwell Taylor Commissioner as hereinafter mentioned
of the first part, and Oliver R. Fiers of the County of Southampton of the second
part; Whereas that whereas by a Decree of the Circuit Superior Court of
Law and Chancery for the County of Southampton pronounced on the 10th day of
March 1848 in a certain suit therein pending between Wm. R. Bishop deceased, plaintiff and
his next right and as administrator of said W. R. Bishop deceased, plaintiff and
John A. Tucker Executor of William H. Sparks deceased, who was Executor of
Clemente Rockhill deceased and others Defendants it was adjudged ordered and decreed
that Richard A. Grump who was jointly appointed as Commissioner for that purpose
should sell at public auction certain Lands therein mentioned of which Clemente
Rockhill died seized after giving the Notice therein required of the time and place
of sale: and whereas the said Richard A. Grump, in pursuance of the said
Decree, did report to sale the Lands of the said Clemente Rockhill thereby
subscribed to be sold on the 17th day of February 1849, at which said sale
the said Oliver R. Fiers became the purchaser of the tract of Land hereinafter
particularly described and paid in Cash five Dollars and thirty six cents and
executed his bond payable to the said Richard A. Grump, as Commissioner under
Months after sale for the sum of one hundred and one Dollars and eighty four
cents being the amount of the purchase money of the said tract of Land with
Thomas B. Driscoll and John D. Brooke as Sureties which said bond was returned
by the said Commissioner with his Report to the said Court; and whereas by
another Decree pronounced in the said Court by the said Court on the 5th day of
March 1849 the sale so made by the said Commissioner, was confirmed and it was
then and there decreed that Jazwell Taylor the Attorney for the specially Creditor
of Clemente Rockhill deceased who had proved that Clemente before the Commission
in said Cause should receive from the Clerk of the Court the said bond
either bonds returned by the said Commissioner and should collect the same and
upon the payment thereof the said Jazwell Taylor was by said Decree appointed
as special Commissioner to receive and deliver to the respective purchasers of the said
Lands as aforesaid by the said Richard A. Grump as Commissioner proper Bonds for the
