Now remaining of Record, in said Court; and whereas the said Honoring J. Smith has paid to the said Tazewell Taylor the amount of the said lands the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged: Now this Indenture witnesses that the said Tazewell Taylor Commissioner as aforesaid by virtue of the authority vested in him by the Decree herein last mentioned for and in consideration of the payment of the said sum of five hundred & sixty nine dollars & twenty five cents to him by the said Honoring J. Smith has granted bargained and sold and by that grants does grant bargain and sell unto the said Honoring J. Smith his heirs and assigns all that certain tract piece or parcel of Land in the County of Southampton of which Clements Rochelle died seized having the "Home tract" containing by recent survey two hundred and thirty and one half acres (the family Burying ground being reserved) and also that certain other tract piece or parcel of Land situate in the said County whereof the said Clements Rochelle died seized called the "Muffet tract" containing one hundred and thirty four acres to have and to hold the said lands piece or parcels of Land that are known as the "Home tract" as aforesaid subject to the reservations aforesaid and thereto known as the "Muffet tract" with the appurtenances unto him the said Honoring J. Smith his heirs and assigns forever of him the said Tazewell Taylor Commissioner as aforesaid free from the claims and demands of him the said Tazewell Taylor and of all persons claiming by through or under him but against the demands of him or other persons whatsoever. And witness that the said Tazewell Taylor Commissioner as aforesaid has hereat his hand and seal the day and year first herein written.

This Indenture made and entered into this eighteenth day of February nineteenth hundred and fifty between Tazewell Taylor Commissioner as herein before named of the first part and Eliakim Joyner John D. Brink and Joseph Bull of the County of Southampton of the second part; Witnesseth that whereas by Decree of the Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery for the County of Southampton pronounced on the 10th day of November 1848 in at which said Court sitting Honoring J. Smith in his own right and as administrator of said deceased and plaintiff and John M. Suckey Executor of William D. Sparks deceased who was Executor of Clements Rochelle deceased and their Defendants it was good ordered and decreed that Richard A. Grump who was then appointed
