 Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and fifty, between William Hodgprich
 of the County of Southampton and parish of Northway of the one part and William
 B. Jaynes of the other part; Witnesseth that the said William Hodgprich for
 and in consideration of the sum of twenty one Dollars and fifty Cents and some
 Money to him paid in hand paid by the said William B. Jaynes the Receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged with grant, bargain, sell and confirmed, and
 by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said William B. Jaynes
 to him and his heirs forever a certain Tract or parcel of Land containing by
 estimation six acres three Rods and four poles. In the Town of More or less and bounded
 as follows to wit: Beginning at a small pine at corner tree in William Hodgprich
 and the Land belonging to the heirs of Elias Whitfield and W. B. Jaynes line
 thence to a Red Oak at new Market corner tree in William Hodgprich line thence
 along a line of marked trees in said Hodgprich line to a pine in said
 Hodgprich line, thence along said Hodgprich line to a pine at corner tree
 in William Hodgprich, John Brackshaw and William B. Jaynes line
 thence along said line to a White Oak at corner tree in William Hodgprich
 and William B. Jaynes line, thence along said Jaynes line to the first
 beginning. Together with all houses edifices &c. whatsoever belonging or in any
 wise appertaining to the said tract or parcel of land, and premises. To have and
 to hold the same unto the said William B. Jaynes to him and his heirs forever
 and the said William Hodgprich do by these presents grant to and with the
 said William B. Jaynes that he will warrant and forever defend all right title
 claim or demand to the same or any part thereof. In Witness whereof the
