This Indenture made and entered into the twenty seventh day of
December one thousand eight hundred and forty nine between Joseph S. Sikes
and Sarah his wife and Arthur Middleton and George B. Middleton of the
one part and William Ward and James Barnes of the other part, do hereby
covenant that the said Joseph S. Sikes and wife and Arthur Middleton and
George B. Middleton for and in consideration of the sum of two thousand
dollars which is to them in hand paid by the said William Ward
and James Barnes and the other thousand by a mortgage from the said
Ward & Barnes to the said Sikes & wife and Arthur & George B. Middleton
the Receipt of which thousand dollars is hereby acknowledged, have
granted bargained and sold and by their private acts, grants, bargains, sell
and deliver unto the said William Ward and James Barnes their heirs
and assigns or certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County
of Southampton State of Virginia containing by estimation one thousand
one hundred and seventy two acres be the same more or less being
in value of which said is conveyed to William Ward and the other third
to James Barnes being a portion of that tract of Land which was conveyed
to Arthur Middleton by Thomas Rickett and wife and William B. Sweeney
and wife and others by Deed bearing date the twenty eighth day of February
one thousand eight hundred and thirty one which tract of Land conveyed
in the above Deed from Rickett & Sweeney containing three hundred and
seventy three acres and four fourths and now excepted two hundred & a half
acres which have been before sold and conveyed to Octavius Bruton by Deed
bearing date December the twentieth 1847 having an inclosure of a hundred
and seventy two and a half acres which are hereby conveyed to the said William
Ward and James Barnes to have and to hold the aforesaid tract of about
hundred and seventy two & a half acres with all and singular the appurtenances
thereunto belonging to the said William Ward & James Barnes their heirs & assigns
forever, not the portion or parcel of Land which has been before conveyed
to the said Octavius Bruton is defined and distinctly marked out by a plot or
diagram prepared by Thomas B. Darnell Surveyor, which Diagram accompanies
and is attached to this Deed from Sikes wife Arthur & George B. Middleton to Ward
and Barnes all of which with regard to said Deed & said Diagram well more
fully appears by reference to the Records of the County Court of Southampton
and the said Joseph S. Sikes and Sarah his wife hereby covenant with the said
William Ward and James Barnes that they are entitled to three hundred and
eighty one acre part of the tract of Land above conveyed for and during the life
of the said Sarah being the same which has been allotted to her as Dowry in the
will estate of her former husband Arthur Middleton and the said Arthur and
George B. Middleton for themselves their heirs & assigns covenant to said wife
the said William Ward & James Barnes that they are possessed of an estate
in fee simple in the residue of the said tract of Land and that they do and
