that the said Henry Blow for and in consideration of the sum of eight Dollars to
him in hand paid at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted, bargained and sold and by these
presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Osmond Vick his heirs and
assigns one small piece or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton
and is supposed to contain one acre and a fourth of an acre more or less and
being a part of a Tract of Land now owned by said Henry Blow bounded by
the said Henry Blow's Land and Richard S. Vick. Commencing at a post or corner
Middle of a small branch being a side line between Richard S. Vick and Henry
Blow, thence along the said branch to a black gum at side between said Henry
Blow and Richard S. Vick: It is now agreed to hold the above piece or parcel of
Land and premises with their appurtenances unto him the said
Osmond Vick his heirs or assigns: And Witness whereof the said parties of the
first part have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year
