Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Jesse Johnson at or before the
making and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof the said Alfred J.
Stephenson and Elizabeth Ann his wife doth hereby acknowledge and chiefly
satisfies and discharges the said Jesse Johnson his heirs Executors admors
and assigns forever by these presents to the said Alfred J. Stephenson and
Elizabeth Ann his wife hath granted bargained sold and by these presents doth
grant bargain and sell unto the said Jesse Johnson his heirs and assigns forever
all that tract or parcel of Land with the appurtenances situate lying and
being in the County aforesaid and bounded as follows on the east and south
by the Lands of Alfred J. Stephenson Allen Edwards and others Commencing
at a point on the Road and thence along a line of marked trees to a Red oak
in Allen Edwards line and along said line to a burnt stump in the same branch
and up said branch to a point the corner of the School house Land and
thence a line of marked trees to a post in the Road leading from Jerusalem
to Black Water bridge and down said Road to the beginning Continuing by
recent survey forty four rods over one Road and right thence to the same
