This Indenture made and entered into the first day of February in the
 year of our lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and fifty, between Winston
 Griffen of the County of Southampton and Parish of Newbury of the one part
 and John Taggart of the same County and Parish of the other part, Witnesseth
 that the said Winston Griffen for and in consideration of the sum of forty dollars
 current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said John Taggart the
 Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained, sold and confirmed
 and by these presents shall grant bargain and sell unto the said John Taggart his heirs
 and his heirs forever a certain tract or parcel of Land containing by estimation forty
 and a half acres, be the same more or less and bounded as follows, to wit, beginning
 at a point in the edge of the Cypress swamp in George Johnsons line thence
 along said Johnsons line to a pine tree along said Johnsons line to a black locust
 in the Myrtle branch in said said Johnsons line and from said black locust
 thence along down the said branch to the Cypress swamp adjoining the lands
 of the said Winston thence up the said swamp to the first station together with all
 the appurtenances whatsoever belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said tract
 of Land, and promises to have and to hold the same unto the said John Taggart
 his heirs and his heirs forever, and the said Winston Griffen doth by these presents
 grant to and with the said John Taggart that he will warrant and defend all
 right title claim or demand to the same or any part thereof. IN WITNESS WHEREOF
