and by these presents do and make of them doth bargain and sell unto
the said Stich H. Bishop his heirs and assigns, the premises
hereinabove party, of a tract of Land lying in the said County, on the south
side of Nottlingay river adjoining the Lands of the & Dealer containing
by estimation about acres it being the same tract of Land on which
the said Stich H. Bishop now resides to which the said Nancy J.
is entitled as one of the heirs at Law of her deceased father James
Bishop, together with all and singular the houses thereon, barns,
buildings, stables, yards, gardens, orchards, lands, tenements, plantations
forests, Common lands, underwoods, wayes walkes water courses, fishings
privileges, profits, easements, commonalties, advantages, emoluments, hereditaments
and appurtenances whatsoever to the said undivided several parts of the
