This Indenture made & entered into this 16<sup>th</sup> day of February one thousand eight hundred & fifty between James Jagers & Nancy his wife & Harrison Beale of the one part and Harrison Jagers of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said James Jagers & Nancy his wife & Harrison Beale for an in consideration of one hundred Dollars to them in hand paid by him the said Harrison Jagers at the making and delivering of these presents, have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said Harrison Jagers his heirs and assigns all certain Tract of Land containing by estimation fifty acres situate being that part of the Land formerly to Elias Beale lying West of a branch running across the said plantation beginning at Carr Rivers line running a line of Mark trees to a water oak in the branch thence running up the branch between Elisha Randolph & Harrison Beale to a gum corner in the said branch thence a straight line to a pine corner of Harrison James land and thence bounded, &c. &c. by the said Harrison James land to the beginning; To Have and to hold the aforesaid premises with all the appurtenances and improvements and ornaments yearly and other Beale forever the said James Jagers & Nancy his wife and Harrison Beale do hereby warrant and will forever the aforesaid premises for from all claims & demands from all or every person whatsoever; In Testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals this day and year as is before written
