 Honoring Trustee by a certain Indenture bearing date the 18th day of February
 1849 and admitted to Record in the Court of Southampton, did grant, lease
 and convey to the said Honoring J Smith Trustee his heirs & assigns all that
 tract or parcel of Land on which the said Henry Factor stands lying and
 being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia containing by
 estimation one hundred and four acres more or less, and adjoining the Lands
