This Indenture, made and entered into on this 21<sup>st</sup> day of January in the year  
of our Lord, Eighteen hundred and fifty, between William D. Bryant and Margaret  
Bryant, his wife, (formerly Margaret Lawrence) of the County of Southampton and  
State of Virginia, of the one part, and James Wells of the same County and  
State, of the other part: Witnesseth that the said William D. Bryant and  
Margaret his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and  
twenty five dollars current money of this Commonwealth, to them in  
hand paid by the said James Wells, at or before the sealing and de-  
livery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Have  
granted, bargained, and sold, and by these presents do and each of  
them doth grant, bargain and sell unto him the said James Wells,  
his Heirs and assigns forever, One certain tract or parcel of Land,  
situate, lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton, and Par-  
ish of Northway, containing Eighty five acres (or the same more or less)  
and bounded by the lands of said James Wells, James W. Mungo and others  
it being the land recently allotted to the said William D. Bryant  
and Margaret, his wife by the Commissioners appointed to divide  
the lands of William E. Lawrence dec'd, (the father of said Margaret)  
who reserves to Mrs. Priscilla Gordon, the mother of said Margaret  
Bryant, the right and privilege to take fire wood and fence rail timber  
therefrom during the term of her natural life; and the same reservation  
is hereby made, the said William D. Bryant and Margaret, his wife,  
hereby conveying the said eighty five acres of Land, as it was allotted  
to them by the said Commissioners: To have and to hold the above  
described tract or parcel of Land and premises, with all and singular  
the appurtenances thereto belonging, except Mrs. Gordon's right to fire  
wood and fence rail timber as above mentioned, unto him the said  
James Wells, his Heirs and assigns, And the said William D. Bryant  
and Margaret his wife, for themselves, their Heirs, Executors and Assigns do and  
each of them doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said James  
Wells, his Heirs, Executors Assigns and Assigns, that they will in these  
presents warrant and forever defend all the right and title of the aforesaid  
tract or parcel of Land and premises hereby conveyed (except as above  
excepted), against the claims or demands of all and every other person  
or persons whatsoever. In Witness whereof, the said William D.  
Bryant and Margaret his wife have hereunto set their hands and  
affixed their seals, the day and year first above written.
