

bargain, sell & confirm unto the said Thomas B. Wourell and his heirs forever all that tract or parcel of land lying in the said County of Southampton, on which the said William Joyner late now resides containing by survey two hundred & fifteen acres of land to the same however, even so much more or less, and bounded as fol-  
lows toward by the lands of Ruth H. Bishop, Bony-Daughtry, John M. Gurley & Martha Rockelle together with all the hereditaments belong-  
ing or in any wise appertaining thereto: To have and to hold the said  
tract of land with all of the hereditaments, privileges and ap-  
pertinences; in any wise thereto belonging, to the said Thomas  
B. Wourell and his heirs forever, to the only proper use and  
service of the said Thomas B. Wourell and his heirs forever  
and the said William Joyner and Anna his wife for themselves  
and their heirs do covenant and agree with the said Thomas Wourell  
his heirs and assigns, that the said Joyner and his wife are  
lawfully and rightfully seized of the premises aforesaid with all &  
the privileges thereto belonging of a perfect and indefeasible  
estate of inheritance in fee simple, without any condition or re-  
straint whatsoever to alter, change, lessen or defeat the same  
tract or parcel of Land.

Upon trust nevertheless, that the said Thomas B. Wourell  
his heirs & assigns, shall permit the said William Joyner to remain in  
quiet and peaceable possession of the said tract of land and its privileges  
& appurtenances aforesaid, and to take the profits thereof to his use  
until the said Davis Barrett, his heirs, assigns or representa-  
tives shall have sustained some pecuniary loss by reason of and in  
consequence of his securityship for the said Joyner: Then upon the  
further trust, that as soon as the said Davis Barrett his executors  
administrators or assigns shall have sustained any loss there-  
fore, and as soon thereafter as they shall receive the said  
Thomas B. Wourell, to sell the tract or parcel of land aforesaid  
with its privileges and appurtenances, or such part thereof  
as shall be sufficient for the purpose at public auction  
to the highest bidder for cash or ready money, after having  
fixed the time & place of sale at his own discretion and given  
twenty days notice thereof by advertisement posted in two  
proper places in said County and out of the process of the  
sale, shall & will, after satisfying the expence thereof &  
other expence attending the execution of this trust, pay to the said  
Davis Barrett, his executors, administrators or assigns, the sum in  
whole amount which the said Davis Barrett, his executors, adminis-  
trators or assigns may have paid by reason of the securityship  
of the said Davis Barrett as aforesaid, with interest on the sum  
from the time of such payment by the said Davis Barrett,  
till the same is repaid under & by virtue of this deed first  
and the balance, if any, shall to the said William Joyner,  
his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns: But if the whole  
of the said debt and accruing interest shall be fully
