Holland the following property to-wit: one Bed andstead and furniture, half a Doz: chairs, one Table one dozen cups and saucers, one dozen plates, three dishes, smery articles & cooking utensils, all my Carpenter's tools, etc, etc, any article in the way of House furniture - So have and to hold the aforesaid property to the other property we and brook him the said C. Holland his executors, administrators and assigns forever - And I the said Joseph Carter, for myself, my executors and administrators the aforesaid property, to the said C. Holland, his executors, administrators and assigns, the said C. Holland, his executors, administrators and assigns, the said Joseph Carter my executors, administrators and assigns and against all and every person whatsoever shall, will and do warrant & forever defend by these presents - I do witness my hand
