

Ino: No: Glouc., estate of Sab: D. Parker, Esq'male & son and Lucy Bondall and
 children containing 2 26 acres by the same more or less together with all its fixtures
 & improvements therunto belonging, the said Waller and wife together with
 the said Trustees, do further sell and convey to the said James E. Peters the fol-
 lowing property: negro woman Adeline Robetus, California, child & child,
 Rosetta, Adolphus, and the future increase of said females. Three beds & furniture
 one Walnut Dresser, one Walnut dining Table, one Bureau, one bay horse,
 one York oxen, two cows & calf. To have and to hold to him the
 said James E. Peters, his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Levi L.
 Waller & Elizabeth his wife and said Matthew T. Peters and Nicholas Cook
 as Trustees as before named, do for themselves their heirs and assigns, do
 covenant with the said James E. Peters his heirs and assigns, that they will and
 their heirs, assigns, executors &c shall warrant and defend the title to the said
 property to the said James E. Peters his heirs and assigns forever against the legal
 claims and demands of all persons whatever. Upon trust nevertheless that the
 said James E. Peters his heirs and assigns shall permit the said Waller and
 wife to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of this said tract of land and
 slaves and other property herein conveyed and to take the profits thereof to their
 own use; until default be made in the said sum of three hundred dollars
 with legal interest, with all other expenses attending this deed, in whole or
 in part, and then upon this further trust that the said James E. Peters
 shall and will so soon after the happening of such default of payment, as
 he shall be requested by the said Samuel Drury or his heirs or assigns, so to do,
 sell the said land and other property herein conveyed or such part thereof as will
 be sufficient for the purpose to the highest bidder at action for ready money
 after having given the time and place of sale at his own discretion and given
 timely notice, say at least twenty days, at three different publick places,
 and out of the proceeds of sale, shall after satisfying the expenses thereof: and
 all other expenses attending the execution of this deed, pay to the said
 Samuel Drury or to his heirs, executors or assigns, the debt aforesaid and
 Interest thereon or such part as may be due, and the balance, if any,
 pay to the said parties herein conveying or to their heirs or assigns. But
 if the whole debt and accruing Interest shall be fully paid off, to the said
 Drury or his heirs or assigns, before the 1st day of June next, so
 that no default of payment be made in the said debt and expenses
 attending this Trust, then this Indenture to make void or else to remain
 in full force.
