Rowland trustee, of the first part, and Robert Rowland of the same County, of the second part: Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred one dollars and - cents to me in hand paid by the said Robt. Rowland the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and conveyed and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto him the said Robt. Rowland all the tract of land held by me as trustee for John R. Waller wife & children, containing 100 acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows. North by the lands of Lucy S. Parker, East by Robt. Rowland, South by Robt. Ridley, and West by Winnie Pittaway - to have and to hold the above granted premises to him, the said Robt. Rowland and his heirs forever. And the said Levi C. Waller Commissioner as aforesaid covenants with the said Robt. Rowland, that he shall have a good and perfect title to the same free from the claim of him the said Levi C. Waller Commissioner or any other person claiming by or through him as Commissioner, authorized to sell under the decree of the Court.
