

Boykin This Indenture, made the 15th day of June in the year one thousand eight
 hundred and fifty, between Francis M. Boykin of the one part, and Jas. O.
 Bryant President & others of the board of overseers & their successors of the other
 part, Witnesseth that the said Francis M. Boykin in consideration of five
 hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Jas. O. Bryant President & others
 of the board of overseers &c. at or before the sealing and delivery of these
 presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargain-
 ed and sold, and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell unto
 the said Jas. O. Bryant President & others of the board of overseers &c. a certain tract
 of land situated in the County of Southampton, adjoining the poorhouse tract
 containing one hundred and forty two and one half acres or thereabouts
 more or less and bound as follows: Beginning in the center of the Cattail
 Swamp on William Griffin's line, thence north along the said Griffin's line
 of marked trees to Wm. Atkinson's line; thence along the said Atkinson's line
 to the poorhouse tract, thence along the said poorhouse tract to the
 center of the Cattail Swamp, thence up said Swamp to the beginning,
 together with all and singular the premises and appurtenances therunto
 belonging - To have and to hold the said land and appurtenances
 unto the said Jas. O. Bryant President & others of the board of overseers and their
 successors free from the claim or claims of him the said Francis M.
 Boykin and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall, will and
 do warrant and forever defend by these presents - In witness whereof the
 said Francis M. Boykin hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his
