

Wm. L. Corvett, in the tract of Land on which he lives together with all improvements thereon, for the sum of Ten dollars, for the express purpose of furnishing my Father above named with a house, and also in order that my old father Wm. L. Corvett, who is an invalid and so infirm, that he is not able to support himself and family might live on the said Land and attend the management and cultivate the same for the true intent and purpose of supporting my younger sisters above named together with myself and thereby enable him to live without assistance from the publick. Therefore in order to carry into effect my true intentions in regard to my sisters aforesaid and my old father, for my good will and affection for them, I do this day by these presents loan, give grant, and convey to my father Wm. L. Corvett agent, trustee or trust friend as aforesaid for my sisters Salinda A., Martha C., Rebecca L., Mary J., Clayette L. W. and Margaret L. Corvett, all my right, title and interest to the said Land and improvements, the title and description of which will more fully than by referring to Jesse Drury's deed to me, who was the trustee, which is recorded in the Clerk's Office of Co. Anson, unto him agent as aforesaid for the true purpose, meaning and intent of this deed, which will be more fully explained in the latter part of this deed - as follows: That notwithstanding, I do hereby convey to my father Wm. L. Corvett agent as aforesaid all my right and title to the aforesaid Land for the purposes herein contained. I do it expressly for my affection, for my sisters aforesaid and that my father may may be engaged at a home a during his life and not be chargeable to the publick. Therefore it is my intention that this deed shall be so construed as to make the Land subject to any debt he may owe or may hereafter owe, but expressly for the true intent thereof, that is to say that my father shall cultivate the same, to make support for my sisters aforesaid, for their express benefit. at the same time his attention will be worth his support and his wife. And further whenever either of my sisters may marry the right and privilege and all benefits hereby secured to them, or when I may marry mine also shall cease and be void, it being my true intention to leave my father in quiet and peaceable possession of the said Land during his life, at the same time that all crops and benefits shall in part be by my sisters & myself until marriage, under all the above considerations. In having in the commencement of this deed conveyed all my interest in the aforesaid tract of land with several conditions. I do now warrant, confirm and agree with my father Wm. L. Corvett, that all rights, titles and interests I may have shall be henceforth vested in him as agent, trustee or trust friend as aforesaid apot the claim of myself, my heirs, Exors, administrators or assigns or apot any person claiming for me or in my name, and apot all and every other person or persons, unto him the said Wm. L. Corvett agent and trust friend for my sisters Salinda A., Martha C., Rebecca L., Mary J., Clayette L. W. and Margaret L. Corvett to and for the true intent and meaning of this deed.
