Lawrence This Inventory made this 13<sup>th</sup> day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty, between Ludlow Lawrence of Southampton County, of the one part, and Ben Bowens of the same County of the other part: Witnesseth, that the said Ludlow Lawrence for and in consideration of Twenty dollars cash in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold and by these presents do hereby bargain and sell unto the said Ben Bowens his heirs and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County aforesaid, containing by estimation five acres, to the same more or less - and bounded as follows (viz.) beginning at a small gum standing on the north side of the run of the Spring Branch, and now a fair and apt tree in the said Lawrence's & Bowens line, thence up the said branch to a pine standing where the line of the said Lawrence and Bowens again crosses the said branch, thence south along a line of marked trees, to a Post Oak, a corner tree, thence north East along a line of marked trees to the gum, the first station, together with all and every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said five acres of land with all the premises and advantages of all kinds whatsoever, unto the said Ben Bowens and his heirs forever - And the said Ludlow Lawrence for himself and his heirs the said five acres of Land & premises, do hereby warrant and defend against all persons claiming thereon unto the said Ben Bowens and his heirs forever -
