This Indenture, made and extend into this 16<sup>th</sup> day of July 1850, Between Lawrence Pope of the first part, John Barkham of the second part, and B. C. & H. P. Pope, B. C. & G. C. Pope, C. D. Barkham, Peter Edwards, Clarke & Pope, Samuel Drewry, L. Fountainward, Isaac Davis above Executors of Rebecca Reese, Mills L. Gray, C. D. Barkham and Thomas Newson Executors of Nathl Francis dec<sup>d</sup> and John Yates of the third part, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Whereas the said Lawrence Pope is indebted to the said B. C. & H. P. Pope by bond of wren date with this indenture in the sum of one hundred and eighteen Dollars and 89/100 with Int. from date, also to the said B. C. & G. C. Pope by bond date with this indenture in the sum of fifty eight Dollars and 59/100 with Int. from date, to the said C. D. Barkham by bond dated with this indenture for Ten Dollars to the said Peter Edwards by bond dated about May Court 1850 in the sum of about thirty four Dollars, to Clarke & Pope by bond dated July 15<sup>th</sup> 1850 for Twenty eight Dollars and 59/100, to Samuel Drewry by bond due Oct. 18<sup>th</sup> 1849 in the sum of Nineteen Dollars and 89/100 subject to a credit of nine Dollars and 9/100 made Jun 17<sup>th</sup> 1850, to L. Fountainward by bond dated the 21<sup>st</sup> of March 1850 for fifty nine Dollars and on demand six months after date, and assigned to Edward P. Summ by said Fountainward, to Isaac Davis above of Rebecca Reese dec<sup>d</sup> in the sum of Twenty six dollars and some cents, executed sometime in the winter of 1849 or 1850, to Mills L. Gray by bond dated 11<sup>th</sup> Oct. 1849 for seven Dollars and 17/100 to C. D. Barkham and Thomas Newson Executors of Nathl Francis dec<sup>d</sup> by three bonds one for Twenty Dollars, one for about Twenty six Dollars another for about Twenty nine Dollars, all dated some time in the winter of 1849 or 1850, and due sometime in the fall of 1850, also one note to John Yates, apt for Wm. C. Clarke executed in the winter or spring of 1850 for eleven Dollars or thereabouts, and the said Lawrence Pope being willing and desirous to secure all the aforesaid debts and Interest. Now this indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and for the further consideration of one Dollar to him in hand paid by the said John Barkham at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said Lawrence Pope hath given granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents doth give grant, bargain and sell to the said John Barkham his heirs and assigns forever the following property, to wit: The tract of Land on which the said Lawrence Pope lieth containing one hundred and Twenty one acres be the same more or less and adjoining the Lands of Jacob Williams, Mills L. Gray and Wm. Bryant, also one bay Horse, one small mare and future increase in herd of cows and their future increase, Twenty two hogs and their future increase, Two beds, and furniture, Twelve setting chairs, three Tables, one safe, three pots, one oven, one spider, with all other articles of household and kitchen furniture, one bed and
