Know all men by these presents, that we Nathan N. Thomas and Elizabeth his wife of the County of Southampton in consideration of Two hundred and fifty dollars to us in hand paid by Lemuel B. Murrell of the said County, the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Lemuel B. Murrell his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land situate in the said County, bounded and described as follows: vizt: By the land of Mark A. James, John A. Brown, William B. Westbrook and the land belonging to the estate of Joseph T. Cloud deceased containing by estimation fifty acres or there more or less, together with all the privileges and appurtenances to the said land in any wise appertaining and belonging, and I, the said Nathan N. Thomas do further covenant with the said Lemuel B. Murrell, that he the said Murrell is to take full and peaceable possession of all the woods land immediately. But the said N. N. Thomas reserves to himself the possession of the field now in cultivation until the 25th day of November next. To have and to hold the above granted premises to the said Lemuel B. Murrell his heirs and assigns forever. And I, the said Nathan N. Thomas for myself, my heirs, executors, and administrators, do covenant with the said Lemuel B. Murrell his heirs and assigns, that I and my said wife are lawfully seized in fee of the before granted premises, that they are free from all incumbrances, that I and my said wife have a good and perfect right to sell and convey the same to the said Lemuel B. Murrell his heirs and assigns forever, and that I will and my heirs, executors, and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Lemuel B. Murrell his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons - In testimony whereof, I, the said Nathan N. Thomas and my Elizabeth my wife, have hereunto set our hands and seals this 31st day of July eighteen hundred and fifty.
