Know all men by these presents, that I, Lemuel B. Murrell of the County of Southampton, in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Edward P. Turner of the said County, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Edward P. Turner his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land situated in the said County, bounded and described as follows, to-wit: By the Lots of Mark S. James, John S. Lison, William B. Westbrook and the lands belonging to the estate of Joseph T. Bland dec'd, containing by estimation fifty acres, be the same more or less, together with all the privileges and appurtenances to the said land in any wise appertaining and belonging, and I, the said Lemuel B. Murrell do further covenant with the said Edward P. Turner, that he the said Edward P. Turner is to take full and peaceable possession of all the wood land immediately. But the said Lemuel B. Murrell reserves to himself the possession of the field now in cultivation until the 25th day of December next. To have and to hold the above granted premises to the said Edward P. Turner his heirs and assigns forever. And I, the said Lemuel B. Murrell for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said Edward P. Turner his heirs and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the before granted premises, that they are free from all incumbrances, that I have a good and perfect right to sell and convey the same to Edward P. Turner his heirs and assigns aforesaid, and that I will and my heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Edward P. Turner his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons. In testimony whereof, I, the said Lemuel B. Murrell have hereunto set my hand and seal this 3rd day of August, eighteen hundred and fifty.
