This indenture made and entered into this eighteenth day of October in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty, between Benjamin E. Pope of the first part, Bartwell Worrell of the second part and John I. Kindred and Benjamin B. Kindred executors of Henry Kindred deceased of the third part, all of the County of Southampton and, State of Virginia: Whereas the said Bartwell Worrell on the eighteenth day of January in the year 1841, in order to secure the payment of the sum of one hundred and eighty three dollars and thirty eight cents, with lawful interest, then due from the eighteenth day of January A. D. 1841, to the said Henry Kindred during his lifetime, did by indenture of that date convey to the said Benjamin E. Pope and his heirs a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton near Pope's Store and bounded as follows: by the lands of Walter Pope, William Wilson, John Barham, the heirs of Richard B. Day and Henry Gorman, and supposed to contain eighty one and three fourths acres: upon certain trust therein mentioned; as by reference to said deed of record in the Clerk's office of the County aforesaid, will more fully appear; And whereas since the execution of said trust, the said Bartwell Worrell has fully satisfied and paid to the said Henry Kindred during his life time and to Mrs. J. I. Benjamin B. Kindred, his executors, since his death, the debt thereby intended to be secured, with all interest thereon, which payment the said Mrs. J. I. Benjamin B. Kindred hereby acknowledge; Now this indenture witnesseth that in consideration of the premises, and for the further consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said Bartwell Worrell to the said Benjamin E. Pope, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, by the said Benjamin E. Pope with the approbation and consent of the said Mrs. J. Kindred and Benjamin B. Kindred, affected by their being a party to these presents, and the said Mrs. J. I. Benjamin B. Kindred, do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell release & confirm unto the said Bartwell Worrell & his heirs forever, all the estate, right, title and interest, both in law and equity, which the said Benjamin E. Pope and the said Henry Kindred and his executors Mrs. J. Kindred & Benjamin B. Kindred have, had, or now have possess in and to the said tract or parcel of land & its privileges & appurtenances, conveyed by the deed of trust aforesaid: To have and to hold the said tract of land with the privileges & appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said Bartwell Worrell & his heirs forever.

And the said Benjamin E. Pope & Jas. S. Kindred & Benjamin B. Kindred, for themselves and their heirs respectively, as well as for the said deceased Abby Kindred, do solemnly covenant with the said Nathaniel Woodell his heirs & assigns, that they the said Pope & Jas. S. B. Kindred and their respective heirs, shall and will forever warrant and defend the title to said land into its privileges & appurtenances against to the said Nathaniel his heirs & assigns against the claims of themselves respectively, not of all and every person claiming by, through or under them, but against the claims of no other person whatsoever.
